




18th Hellenic Symposium on Medicinal Chemistry (HSMC-18) is organized (**5-7 November 2020, War Museum, Athens, Greece**) by the **Hellenic Society of Medicinal Chemistry (HSMC)**.

It continues the tradition of biannual meetings established since 35 years in Greece as a forum for the discussion of recent advances in medicinal chemistry.

The topics include drug design and lead identification and optimization, protein-protein interactions and protein degradation, ADME/Tox properties, advances in Synthetic Medicinal Chemistry, Natural Products, Pharmacology as well as the impact of artificial intelligence in the integration of data-intensive practices to Drug Discovery.

Sections on Pharmaceutical Analysis will be integrated in the symposium program.



ABSTRACTS GUIDELINES

The following guidelines are common for **Oral (deadline 4th September 2020)** or **Poster (deadline 30th September 2020)** Presentations and all authors are kindly requested to follow them for abstracts submission

- Abstracts should be submitted online (www.helmedchem2020.gr) or via e-mail at k.ge@zita-congress.gr to the attention of Mr. Gerasimos Kouloumpis
- The abstract must be written in English
- The abstract must be submitted in word format doc or docx

The abstract should be structured as follows:

1. Title in capital letters, bold, font 14, Times New Roman or Arial, One empty line

2. Full author names. The author who will present the work should be underlined, One empty line
3. Affiliations of all authors. (institutions, universities etc). Refer to authors' name according to institution with an asterisk. e.g. Surname Name*, Surname Name**

* Institution A, ** Institution B, One empty line

4. Abstract text. It can include figures and one or two references

Abstracts (including titles, names, address and the full text) should not exceed one A4 page in total, using (except for the title) fonts 12 Times New Roman or Arial, single space and default margins (top 2.54 cm, below 2.54 cm, left 3.18 cm right 3.18 cm)





SYMPOSIUM VENUE

The War Museum was established by the Hellenic State in 1964 in order to honor all those who fought for the country's freedom. The relevant study was undertaken by a team of distinguished scientists, headed by Professor Thoukidides Valentis of the National Technical University of Athens (N.T.U.A). On July 18, 1975, the President of the Hellenic Republic H.E. Constantine Tsatsos and the Minister of National Defense Evangelos Averof-Tositsas inaugurated the Museum.

The Museum's mission, as this was determined by its Establishing Act, is to collect, preserve and exhibit military artifacts and memorabilia, and to study, document and project the sacred struggles of the Greek nation from antiquity to the present day, in order to preserve the national memory and promote the historic continuity of Hellenism. In addition to presenting various periods of our history, the War Museum also operates as a place for:

- Research, study and education.
- Conserving and safeguarding artifacts, memorabilia, etc.
- Organizing periodic exhibitions.

Its various activities include the publication of

books, the establishment and maintenance of monuments and memorials all over Greece and abroad.

The Museum's exhibition areas are distributed over four levels (floors) and present images of Greek history from antiquity to the present. The War Museum has organized and operates the following:

The Amphitheater IOANNIS KAPODISTRIAS is fully equipped with audiovisual equipment of the latest technology and it has a spacious foyer for exhibitions and posters.
